## **INTRODUCTION**

### **VOTE ON ACCOUNT FOR 2010-11**

Schedule 1, paragraph 22 of the Parliamentary Standards Act 2009 requires the Independent Parliamentary Standards Authority to submit to the Speaker's Committee each financial year (other than its first financial year) an estimate of the Authority's income and expenditure.

The Vote on Account provides finance to allow existing services to continue during the early months of the coming financial year, pending Parliament's consideration of the Independent Parliamentary Standards Authority's Resource Estimate for 2010-11.

The Vote on Account is presented in both resource and cash terms. The amounts are normally a standard 45% of the amounts already voted for the corresponding services in the current year, taking account of summer Supplementary Estimates as well as Main and Revised Estimates where appropriate. However after considering the likelihood of additional cash being required in the early part of the 2010-11 financial year, particularly in the period immediately following a General Election, we have applied for 55% of an estimate of the full funding requirement for the 2010-11 financial year. This amount should be sufficient to ensure that funding is not exhausted before the Appropriation Act is passed in the summer, but not so high as to prejudge Parliament's consideration of the main Supply Estimate.

This Vote on Account together with those for the House of Commons (HC 21), National Audit Office (HC 14) Electoral Commission (HC 25), Local Government Boundary Commission for England (HC 27), and those for central government departments (HC 33) will be incorporated in the Consolidated Fund Bill that follows presentation of the Winter Supplementary Estimates 2009-10 and the Vote on Account, which will seek statutory authority for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of a sum equal to the Vote on Account.
